Bill Summary: This legislation confirms the Sheriff's appointment of Jonathan S. Barrier, as Chief of Patrol Support Division, in the Office of the Sheriff, pursuant to Section 37.105, *Ordinance Code*, retroactively effective to April 13, 2024.

Background Information: Section 37.102(a), *Ordinance Code*, provides that division chiefs within the Sheriff's Office shall have a college degree or at least five years' training and experience, and be confirmed by the Council before the appointment becomes permanent.

Pursuant to Section 37.105, *Ordinance Code*, the Department of Patrol and Enforcement provides law enforcement, community relations and police services. The Department of Patrol and Enforcement shall be organized into the following divisions, each of which shall be headed by a division chief: (1) Special Events Division. (2) Patrol Division. (3) Patrol Support Division.

Assistant Chief Barrier holds a bachelor's degree from FSU and a master's degree from American Military University. He has served with JSO since 2007 as a patrol officer, detective, sergeant, lieutenant, zone commander and currently as the Assistant Chief Public Accountability, Personnel and Professional Standards.

Fiscal Impact: The salary range for this position is \$107,432.64 - \$175,400.04 annually
