Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's reappointment of David L. Wakefield to the Jacksonville Housing and Community Development Commission (JHCDC), as a representative from the banking or mortgage banking industry in connection with affordable housing, for a second full term ending November 30, 2024.

Background Information: The JHCDC is established pursuant to Chapter 34, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to provide oversight and guidance to the Housing and Community Development Division; make recommendations on all agreements entered into by the Housing and Community Development Division through the Neighborhoods Department for and on behalf of the City; conduct any required public hearings, undertake the review, take any and all required actions for compliance, and make recommendations to the Council for adoption (and authorize the transmittal) as required by section 420.9076, *Florida Statutes*; and conduct any required public hearings, undertake the review, take any and all required actions for compliance, and recommend to the Council for adoption (and authorize the transmittal) a "Consolidated Plan" as required by 24 CFR Part 91.

Section 34.203, *Ordinance Code*, provides that six of the members of the Commission shall be appointed by the Mayor, representing various categories related to affordable housing.

Mr. Wakefield holds a bachelor's degree in business administration from UNF. He is a Senior Mortgage Planner at PrimeLending, where he has worked since 2008. Mr. Wakefield resides in Duval County in council district 5.
