7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$94,000.00 IN GRANT
8 FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA STATE BOARD OF
9 IMMIGRATION ENFORCEMENT FOR THE JACKSONVILLE
10 SHERIFF'S OFFICE IMMIGRATION GRANT PROGRAM, AS
11 INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 26-028; PROVIDING FOR
12 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S OFFICE;
13 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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15 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2025-2026 fiscal year,
17 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
18 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
19 listed in subsection (b):

27 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

28 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant
29 funds from the Florida State Board of Immigration
30 Enforcement for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
31 Immigration Grant Program. The grant period commenced on

1 October 1, 2025, and continues through June 30, 2026. No
2 local match is required.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
4 Section 1 is to utilize grant funding from the Florida State Board
5 of Immigration Enforcement to obtain a multi-passenger van to
6 transport unauthorized aliens between county, state, and federal
7 detention facilities. A copy of the grant agreement outlining the
8 terms and conditions relative to the grant and use of the grant funds
9 is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this
10 reference.

11 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office
12 shall oversee administration of the project described herein.

13 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
15 without the Mayor's signature.
