## **ORDINANCE 2024-765**

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE HOMELESSNESS INITIATIVES COMMISSION ("COMMISSION"); AMENDING SECTION 86.103 (COMPOSITION; LIAISONS; TERMS; REMOVAL) AND SECTION 86.104 (FUNCTIONS, POWERS 86 DUTIES), CHAPTER (HOMELESSNESS INITIATIVES COMMISSION), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ADD A LIAISON FROM THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT TO THE COMMISSION AND EXTEND BY ONE THE DEADLINES TO CREATE FIVE-YEAR STRATEGIC PLAN AND AN ANNUAL ACTION PLAN; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION INSTRUCTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Council established the Homelessness Initiatives Commission (the "Commission") pursuant to Ordinance 2024-111-E (the "Enabling Ordinance"); and

WHEREAS, the Commission is unable to meet the September 1, 2024 deadline for the creation of an annual Action Plan and the December 31, 2024 deadline for the creation of a five-year Strategic Plan, all as set forth in the Enabling Ordinance, due to an unforeseen delay in the initial member appointments to the Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Commission voted at its August 15, 2024 meeting to request the Council to extend the Strategic Plan and Action Plan deadlines by one year to permit the Commission to have enough time to prepare the same, as reflected in the Meeting Minutes attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals above are incorporated herein by this reference.

Section 2. Amending Section 86.103 (Composition; Liaisons; Terms; Removal) and Section 86.104 (Functions, powers and duties), Chapter 86 (Homelessness Initiatives Commission), Ordinance Code. Section 86.103 (Composition; Liaisons; Terms; Removal) and Section 86.104 (Functions, powers and duties), Chapter 86 (Homelessness Initiatives Commission), Ordinance Code, is amended to read as follows:

## CHAPTER 86 - HOMELESSNESS INITIATIVES COMMISSION

\* \* :

Sec. 86.103. - Composition; Liaisons; Terms; Removal.

\* \* \*

(b) Liaisons. The City Council President shall annually appoint a City Council Member to serve as a liaison to the Commission. In addition, the Sheriff shall appoint a liaison to the Commission from amongst his staff with preference given to an officer who regularly works and interacts with the Duval County homeless and/or chronically unhoused populations. In addition, the Director of Fire and Rescue shall appoint a liaison to the Commission from the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department with preference given to an employee who regularly works and interacts with the Duval County homeless and/or chronically unhoused populations. These are non-voting positions and the liaisons shall not be considered members of the Commission for Florida's Open Meetings Law purposes.

## Sec. 86.104. - Functions, powers and duties.

In addition to such powers, duties and authority as may be set forth elsewhere in the Ordinance Code, the Commission is hereby authorized to:

\* \* \*

- (d) Create a five-year Strategic Plan outlining appropriate programs, services and initiatives to combat homelessness this Strategic Plan should be tailored to address the unique needs of Duval County's homeless and chronic unhoused populations; the initial Strategic Plan shall be presented to the Council committee of reference tasked with reviewing and making recommendations on measures addressing homelessness on or before December 31, 20242025;
- (e) Create an annual Action Plan that includes specific goals and measurables to effectuate the Strategic Plan; the initial Action Plan shall be presented to the Council committee of reference tasked with reviewing and making recommendations on measures addressing homelessness on or before September 1, 20242025;
- (f) Annually review the Strategic Plan and Action Plan and make recommendations to the Council committee of reference tasked with reviewing and making recommendations on measures addressing homelessness for updates and changes to both Plans on or before March 1 each year beginning March 1, 2026;

\* \* \*

Section 3. Codification Instructions. The Codifier and the Office of General Counsel are authorized to make all chapter and division "tables of contents" consistent with the changes set forth herein. Such editorial changes and any others necessary to make the Ordinance Code consistent with the intent of this legislation are approved and directed herein, and changes to the Ordinance Code shall be made forthwith and when inconsistencies are discovered.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
