7 A RESOLUTION CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF
8 RICHMOND D. WYNN, AS A MEMBER OF THE OPIOID AND
9 SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER GRANTS COMMITTEE, AS A
10 MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONAL REPRESENTATIVE,
11 PURSUANT TO SECTION 84.202 (COMPOSITION; CITY
12 COUNCIL LIAISON; TERMS; REMOVAL), PART 2 (OPIOID
13 AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER GRANTS COMMITTEE),
14 CHAPTER 84 (OPIOID SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS GRANTS),
15 *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM ENDING ON
16 JUNE 30, 2025; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2023-350-E established the Opioid and
19 Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee (the "Committee") to act as
20 an advisory body for the City of Jacksonville and to review, evaluate
21 and score grant applications to fund projects and programs aimed at
22 combatting the opioid crisis; and

23 **WHEREAS**, Section 84.202, *Ordinance Code*, outlines the
24 composition of the Committee which shall consist of seven voting
25 members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed
26 by Council and three of whom shall be appointed by the Council
27 President and confirmed by Council; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council President shall each appoint
29 one member to the Committee from each of the following categories:
30 (i) Mental Health Professional, (ii) Peer Specialist, and (iii)
31 Healthcare Professional; and

1 **WHEREAS**, the members of the Committee are chosen to provide
2 knowledge of needed services, shall demonstrate an interest in the
3 impact of opioid-related programs in the community, and a willingness
4 to participate fully in the process; now therefore

5 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

6 **Section 1. Appointment.** The Council hereby confirms the
7 Mayor's appointment of Richmond D. Wynn, a Duval County resident, to
8 the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee, as a Mental
9 Health Professional representative, in accordance with Section 84.202
10 (Composition; City Council Liaison; terms; Removal), Part 2 (Opioid
11 and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee), Chapter 84 (Opioid
12 Settlement Proceeds Grants), *Ordinance Code*, for a first full term
13 expiring on June 30, 2025.

14 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become
15 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
16 without the Mayor's signature.
