Phoenix Products is a manufacturer of custom generator enclosures, fuel tanks and fueling systems for standby power, prime power, and peak shaving power applications. The company was founded in 1991 and was purchased by Ring Power Corporation in 2006. Phoenix Products is located at 1727 Bennett Street within Jacksonville's Northwest Economic Development Fund boundary area. The parent company is evaluating constructing a new administrative building, reconfiguring the site to improve the efficiency, assembly and manufacturing capacity or relocating to a more suitable location.

The project site is constrained by existing development. To construct a new administrative building, they must purchase and demolish an existing building at 1544 E. 8th Street. In order to increase their manufacturing capacity and efficiency they must reconfigure the site and invest in additional infrastructure improvements including utility upgrades, storm water improvements and expanded assembly/staging area. The costs associated with these additional requirements are a material factor for Phoenix Products to remain at their current location.

Estimated costs associated with this retention/expansion project is estimated to be \$2,144,000 and are summarized as follows:

Phoenix estimates that the expansion would result in the creation of an additional 12 new full time jobs at an average wage of \$44,800 (\$21.54 per hour) plus benefits. Phoenix currently employs 85 full time persons at an average wage of \$44,800 plus benefits. Annual payroll averages \$3.8 million plus benefits.
