AN ORDINANCE REZONING APPROXIMATELY 46.67± ACRES LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 7 AT 0 PERCY ROAD, 3025 PERCY ROAD, 3101 PERCY ROAD AND 3111 PERCY ROAD, BETWEEN PERCY CREEK DRIVE AND WILLARD LANE (R.E. NOS. 019453-0002, 019453-0200, 019458-0000 (PORTION), 019459-0000 (PORTION), 019462-0002 AND 019535-0100), AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, OWNED BY LARRY C. HARROLD AND JOAN HARROLD, TRUSTEES UNDER THE HARROLD LIVING TRUST, DATED NOVEMBER 29, 2005, ANDREW C. HARROLD, PAUL D. GEORGE, CHRISTIE L. GEORGE AND NORA J. MILLER, FROM RESIDENTIAL RURAL-ACRE (RR-ACRE) DISTRICT AND AGRICULTURE (AGR) DISTRICT TO RESIDENTIAL LOW DENSITY-60 (RLD-60) DISTRICT, AS DEFINED AND CLASSIFIED UNDER THE ZONING CODE; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE REZONING GRANTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Larry C. Harrold and Joan Harrold, Trustees under the Harrold Living Trust, dated November 29, 2005, Andrew C. Harrold, Paul D. George, Christie L. George and Nora J. Miller, the owners of approximately 46.67± acres located in Council District 7 at 0 Percy Road, 3025 Percy Road, 3101 Percy Road and 3111 Percy Road, between Percy Creek Drive and Willard Lane (R.E. Nos. 019453-0002, 019453-0200, 019458-0000 (portion), 019459-0000 (portion), 019462-0002 and 019535-0100), as more particularly described in Exhibit 1, dated May

17, 2023, and graphically depicted in **Revised Exhibit 2**, both of which are attached hereto (the "Subject Property"), have applied for a rezoning and reclassification of the Subject Property from Residential Rural-Acre (RR-Acre) District and Agriculture (AGR) District to Residential Low Density-60 (RLD-60) District; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department has considered the application and has rendered an advisory recommendation; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, acting as the local planning agency, has reviewed the application and made an advisory recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee, after due notice, held a public hearing and made its recommendation to the Council; and

WHEREAS, taking into consideration the above recommendations and all other evidence entered into the record and testimony taken at the public hearings, the Council finds that such rezoning: (1) is consistent with the 2045 Comprehensive Plan; (2) furthers the goals, objectives and policies of the 2045 Comprehensive Plan; and (3) is not in conflict with any portion of the City's land use regulations; now, therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Property Rezoned. The Subject Property is hereby rezoned and reclassified from Residential Rural-Acre (RR-Acre) District and Agriculture (AGR) District to Residential Low Density-60 (RLD-60) District, as defined and classified under the Zoning Code, City of Jacksonville, Florida.

Section 2. Owner and Description. The Subject Property is owned by Larry C. Harrold and Joan Harrold, Trustees under the Harrold Living Trust, dated November 29, 2005, Andrew C. Harrold, Paul D. George, Christie L. George and Nora J. Miller, and is legally described in Exhibit 1, attached hereto. The applicant is Brian
