**ORDINANCE 2025-68-E**

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$123,958.00 FROM THE  
ANIMAL CARE AND PROTECTIVE SERVICES GENERAL FUND  
PART TIME SALARIES ACCOUNT, TO THE PERMANENT AND  
PROBATIONARY SALARIES AND BENEFITS ACCOUNTS, TO  
FUND PERSONNEL COSTS IN ORDER TO CONVERT FOUR  
(4) PART-TIME ANIMAL PLACEMENT POSITIONS AND TWO  
(2) PART-TIME ANIMAL CARE POSITIONS TO A  
FULL-TIME ANIMAL CARE ASSISTANT POSITION AND TWO  
(2) FULL-TIME ANIMAL PLACEMENT ASSISTANT  
POSITIONS WITHIN THE ANIMAL CARE AND PROTECTIVE  
SERVICES DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF  
ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES, AS INITIATED BY B.T.  
25-039; AUTHORIZING SAID POSITIONS, AS INITIATED  
BY R.C. 25-059; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

**Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2024-2025 fiscal year,  
within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated  
sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$123,958.00 from the Animal Care and Protective Services General Fund Part Time Salaries account, to the Permanent and Probationary Salaries and Benefits accounts in order to convert six (6) hard to fill part-time positions into three full-time positions.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund personnel costs for the conversion of four (4) part-time Animal Placement positions and two (2) part-time Animal Care positions to two (2) full-time Animal Placement Assistant positions and one (1) full-time Animal Care Assistant position within the Animal Care and Protective Services Division of the Office of Administrative Services.

**Section 3. Authorization of Positions.** There are hereby authorized the positions more fully described in R.C. 25-059, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference.

**Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
