AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$1,500,000.00 FROM THE SOLID WASTE DISPOSAL FUND TO OFFSET INCREASED EXPENSES FOR LANDFILL DISPOSAL CHARGES AND CONTRACTOR OPERATING COSTS AT THE TRAIL RIDGE LANDFILL THAT ARE ANTICIPATED TO OCCUR DURING THE REMAINDER OF FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025 DUE TO INCREASED TONNAGE DISPOSAL, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 25-113; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of funds from within the Solid Waste Disposal Fund for increased landfill disposal charges and contractor operating costs at the Trail Ridge Landfill.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund anticipated unbudgeted expenditures at the Trail

Ridge Landfill resulting from increased tonnage disposal. The budgeted tonnage for fiscal year 2024-2025 is 920,000 tons. The landfill has experienced a surge in tonnage throughout this fiscal year with in excess of 740,000 tons having been disposed at the landfill through June of 2025. The projected total tonnage anticipated to be received at the Trail Ridge Landfill for this fiscal year is now expected to reach 996,000 tons, which is 76,000 tons over the budgeted amount. Consequently, this appropriation is necessary to cover the increased costs the City will incur for additional landfill disposal charges and contractor operating costs through the remainder of fiscal year 2024-2025.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
