CM Johnson explained that this street re-naming was to commemorate Ray Charles, who was a part of the fabric of this community and worked there as a street musician before achieving fame. CM Johnson stated that he met with the Volunteers of America and the Cultural Council and was working to coordinate the planning and installation of an art exhibit commemorating Charles' legacy on the street. He also noted that CM Peluso supported the legislation, as the re-naming was within CM Peluso's district. He stated that Ray Charles' legacy was one of harmony and inclusivity and that this re-naming would be in furtherance of those ideals.

CM Carlucci requested to be added as a co-sponsor and offered to assist in finding a funding source for the prospective art exhibit.

CM Howland requested to be added as a co-sponsor.

CM Peluso thanked CM Johnson for his work and noted that this street was part of the historic LaVilla Heritage Trail.

CM Pittman commented on the historical importance of the LaVilla neighborhood, as it was the only neighborhood in the urban core to survive the Great Jacksonville Fire of 1901.
