RESOLUTION 2023-192-A

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC. AS DUVAL COUNTY'S AGENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF APPLYING FOR AND RECEIVING MONEY FROM THE FLORIDA CRIME STOPPERS TRUST FUND PURSUANT TO SECTION 16.555, FLORIDA STATUTES, FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS TO EXPIRE 2026; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO SEND A COPY OF RESOLUTION TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL'S THIS OFFICE, DEPARTMENT OF LEGAL AFFAIRS, AND TO FIRST COAST CRIME STOPPERS, INC. UPON ADOPTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida, pursuant to Section 16.555, Florida Statutes, has established a Crime Stoppers Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Attorney General's Office, Department of Legal Affairs (the "Department"), is authorized by the State of Florida to apply for state and federal grants which meet the purposes of advancing Crime Stoppers in the State of Florida and to deposit all such grant funds received in the Crime Stoppers Trust Fund; and

WHEREAS, funds deposited in the Crime Stoppers Trust Fund are disbursed to units of local government upon application to the Department for funding assistance in accordance with Section 16.555 (5) (a), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, additionally, proceeds from court costs imposed pursuant to Section 938.06, Florida Statutes, shall be deposited into

a separate account within the Crime Stoppers Trust Fund to be used in the judicial circuit in which they were collected, as outlined in Section 16.555(5)(b), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, any county may apply to the Department for a grant from the funds collected in the judicial circuit in which the County is located, however a grant may be awarded only to counties which are served by an official member of the Florida Association of Crime Stoppers, and may only be used to support Crime Stoppers and their programs; only one such official member shall be eligible for support within any county; and

WHEREAS, First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. is the one and only official member of the Florida Association of Crime Stoppers in the Fourth Judicial Circuit serving Duval, Nassau, Baker, Bradford, Clay and Union Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that designating First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. as the agent for Duval County for the purposes described herein to be a just and proper action to take; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Duval County Agent. The City of Jacksonville hereby endorses the efforts of First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. and designates First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. and designates First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. as authorized agent for Duval County for the purpose of applying for, and receiving funds from, the Florida Crime Stoppers Trust Fund pursuant to Sections 16.555(5)(a) and (5)(b), Florida Statutes, for a period of three years to expire 2026.

Section 2. Directive to Circulate. The City Council Legislative Services Division is hereby directed to provide a copy of this Resolution to the Attorney General's Office, Department of Legal Affairs, and First Coast Crime Stoppers, Inc. upon its adoption.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

without the Mayor's signature.
