AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$284,000.00 FROM THE GENERAL FUND MAYOR'S TASK FORCE CONTINGENCY TO SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS ΤO PRIVATE ORGANIZATIONS ACCOUNT WITHIN THE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR ACTIVITY TO SUPPORT THE MLK WEEK OF SERVICE PROGRAMMING TO BE HELD JANUARY 13, 2024 THROUGH JANUARY 20, 2024, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 24-016; INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH UNITED WAY OF NORTHEAST FLORIDA, INC. ("UNITED WAY") FOR PLANNING AND OVERSIGHT OF THE MLK WEEK OF SERVICE PROGRAM; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT WITH UNITED WAY; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER ON BEHALF OF THE CITY AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND UNITED WAY; PROVIDING OVERSIGHT BY THE GRANTS AND CONTRACTS COMPLIANCE DIVISION OF THE FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION 2

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

appropriation of Appropriation - The funding above is an appropriation from the General Fund Mayor's Task Force Contingency to subsidies and contributions to private organizations account within the Martin Luther King, Jr. Activity to support the MLK Week of Service programming, to be held January 13, 2024 through January 20, 2024 with its co-sponsor United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to the United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. ("United Way") for planning and oversight of the MLK Week of Service Program as described in Exhibit 2, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The MLK Week of Service Program is a partnership between the City and its co-sponsor United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. to organize community service activities aimed at uplifting the underserved parts of Jacksonville by pursuing the goals of neighborhood revitalization, improved financial well-being and increased food distribution and honoring the

legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. has received an AmeriCorps grant to implement a day of service around the birthday of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. These additional funds will allow United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. to expand the day of service to a week of service in furtherance of the goals of MLK Week of Service Program.

Section 3. Invoking the Exemption in Section 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to directly procure the professional services of United Way to plan and oversee the MLK Week of Service Program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code. Such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 4. Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with United Way. This waiver is justified because United Way has over a decade of experience coordinating similar programs, including identifying and gathering volunteers and coordinating with area non-profits to assist with programming and events.

Section 5. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with United Way of Northeast Florida, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$284,000.00, subject to the Scope of Services

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and Budget more particularly described in **Exhibit 2**, for a term commencing upon the City's execution of the agreement through September 30, 2024, and all other contracts and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, Ordinance Code.

Section 6. Oversight Department. The Grants and Contract Compliance Division of the Finance and Administration Department shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 7. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
