Bill Summary: The bill appropriates a \$750,000 grant from the Florida Department of Environmental Protection to the Christobel Septic Tank Phase-Out Project. It amends the 2024-28 Capital Improvement Plan to reflect the creation of this project. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Public Works Department is designated as the City's oversight agency for the grant.

Background Information: The Cristobel neighborhood borders the Ribault River and was identified as an area of high priority according to the agreement with JEA to phase out septic tanks. It is the third-ranked area on the Health Department's current list of septic tank phase-out priorities. The appropriation will provide funding for topographical surveys, subsurface utility engineering, soil borings, design of a gravity sewer, design of a force main, design of a pump station, agency permitting, and technical specifications for construction. Use of the funds will be subject to an FDEP Standard Grant Agreement providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds.
