ORDINANCE 2024-626-E

AN ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF LISA V. JOHNSON, A ST. JOHNS COUNTY RESIDENT, AS A MEMBER OF THE CULTURAL SERVICE GRANT PROGRAM COMMITTEE, AS ONE OF THE THREE BOARD MEMBERS, REPLACING LAURA SCHEPIS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 118.605, ORDINANCE CODE, FOR A PARTIAL TERM EXPIRING DECEMBER 31, 2024; ESTABLISHING THAT THE APPOINTEE, A NON-RESIDENT OF DUVAL COUNTY, HAS A SUBSTANTIAL PHILANTHROPIC INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 50.102 (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 50.102 (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), ORDINANCE CODE, AS TO REQUIREMENT THAT THE BILL SPONSOR APPEAR BEFORE THE RULES COMMITTEE PRIOR TO THE APPEARANCE OF THE APPOINTEE; WAIVING COUNCIL RULE 4.1101, APPEARANCE BEFORE COMMITTEE, AS TO THE REQUIREMENT THAT THE APPOINTEE, PRIOR CONFIRMATION, SHALL APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMITTEE TO WHICH CONSIDERATION OF THE APPOINTMENT HAS BEEN REFERRED; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 118.605(a), Ordinance Code, the membership of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall be composed of one non-voting member and ten voting members including one Committee chairperson (non-voting) appointed by the President of the Cultural Council Board of Directors, three other Cultural Council Board Members selected by the Cultural Council Board President and Committee Chairperson, and seven individuals from the community appointed by the aforementioned group (the Cultural Council Board President, Cultural Service Grant Program Committee Chair, and the three Cultural Council Board Members); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 118.605(d), Ordinance Code, all members of the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee shall be confirmed by the City Council; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Confirmation of Appointment. The City Council hereby confirms the appointment of Lisa V. Johnson, a St. Johns County resident with a substantial philanthropic interest in Duval County, to the Cultural Service Grant Program Committee, as one of the three Cultural Council Board members, replacing Laura Schepis, in accordance with Section 118.605, Ordinance Code, for a partial term expiring December 31, 2024.

Section 2. Establishing that the Appointee has a Substantial Philanthropic Interest in Duval County. Section 50.102(b) (Members of boards and commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, requires Board and Commission members be either permanent residents of Duval County or to maintain a substantial economic business interest or substantial philanthropic interest, as determined by the City Council, within Duval County. Although the appointee does not reside within Duval County, Ms. Johnson currently serves in leadership roles

for non-profit and philanthropic organizations based in and serving Duval County, including as the Chair of the Cultural Council of Greater Jacksonville Board of Directors and as Chair Emeritus of the Nonprofit Center of Northeast Florida Board of Directors. Therefore, the Council has determined that Ms. Johnson maintains a substantial philanthropic interest in Duval County.

Section 3. Waiving Section 50.102(c), Ordinance Code. Section 50.102(c) (Members of boards and commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived as to the requirement that the bill sponsor appear before the Rules Committee prior to the appearance of the appointee. Because this legislation was filed requesting emergency passage by the Council, there was not sufficient time during the legislative process for the bill sponsor to appear prior to the appointee.

Section 4. Waiving Council Rule 4.1101 Appearance Before Committee. Council Rule 4.1101, Appearance Before Committee, is hereby waived as to the requirement that the appointee, prior to confirmation, be required to appear before the committee to which consideration of the appointment has been referred. This waiver is granted to facilitate emergency passage of this Ordinance to allow the appointee to fully participate in the Cultural Service Grant Program Council grant process.

Section 5. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. Emergency passage upon introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is an unexpected Cultural Service Grant Program Committee vacancy coinciding with the Cultural Service Grant cycle, and the need for the appointee to fully participate in the grant application review process from the onset.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

without the Mayor's signature.
