**Bill Summary:** This bill is an appropriation of \$3,950 from the National Awards Program – Contributions From Private Sources account to the Miscellaneous Grants and Aids account (\$3,450) and the Miscellaneous Services and Charges account (\$500).

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for awards for recipients in a local National Arts Program art show. This art program is open to City of Jacksonville employees or a member of their immediate family. The appropriated funds will be distributed as awards in a local art show and to offset costs for an exhibition/reception. The program includes five classifications: (1) professional, (2) intermediate, (3) amateur, (4) teen 13-18 years of age, and (5) youth 12 years and under. First place, second place, and third place award winners in the professional, intermediate, and amateur classifications will receive \$350, \$250, and \$150, respectively while first, second, and third place winners in the teen and youth classifications will receive \$150, \$100, and \$50, respectively.
