Bill Summary: This legislation confirms the Sheriff's appointment of David S. Coarsey, as Director of Investigations and Homeland Security, in the Office of the Sheriff, pursuant to Section 37.109, Ordinance Code.

Background Information: Pursuant to Section 37.109, there is established a Department of Investigations and Homeland Security. The Director of the Department of Investigations and Homeland Security shall be the head of the Department of Investigations and Homeland Security. They shall have a college degree or at least five years' experience and commensurate training. The Department of Investigations and Homeland Security shall include the following divisions each of which shall be headed by a division chief:

- (1) Investigations Division
- (2) Homeland Security Division.

Mr. Coarsey has a bachelor's degree in Criminal Justice Administration from the University of North Florida. Mr. Coarsey has worked for JSO since 1995 and has been the Assistant Chief of the Major Cases Section since 2021.
