ORDINANCE 2025-606

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, THE OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY, TO TAKE, OR CAUSE TO BE TAKEN, SUCH ACTIONS AND TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTS AS ARE NECESSARY, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, TO ACCEPT THIRTEENTH AMENDED JOINT CHAPTER 11 PLAN OF REORGANIZATION OF PURDUE PHARMA L.P. AND ITS AFFILIATED DEBTORS DATED MARCH 19, 2025; CYCLE REOUESTING ONE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville has suffered harm from the opioid epidemic and further recognizes that the entire State of Florida has suffered harm from the opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville was a litigating participant in the action styled <u>In re: National Opioid Litigation</u>, MDL No. 2804 (N.D. Ohio) (the "Opioid Litigation") and sued Purdue Pharma L.P. for damages stemming from the opioid epidemic; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville is a participant in the State of Florida's unified plan for the allocation and use of opioid settlement proceeds (the "Florida Plan") pursuant to which the City has received millions of dollars in settlement funds; and

WHEREAS, Purdue Pharma L.P. and its affiliated debtors filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy (the "Bankruptcy") after being sued in the Opioid Litigation; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville holds an eligible claim in the

Bankruptcy; and

WHEREAS, Purdue Pharma L.P. and its affiliated debtors are soliciting votes from eligible claim holders to accept or reject their Thirteenth Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization of Purdue Pharma L.P. and its Affiliated Debtors dated March 19, 2025 (the "Plan"); and

WHEREAS, if the City of Jacksonville accepts the Plan, the City will receive settlement funds from the Bankruptcy through the Florida Plan; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Ordinance is to provide the necessary authorizations for the City of Jacksonville to accept the Plan; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Incorporation of Recitals. The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated herein by this reference.

Documents. The City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor, or her designee, the Office of General Counsel and the Corporation Secretary to take, or cause to be taken, for and on behalf of the City, such actions as are necessary to accept the Thirteenth Amended Joint Chapter 11 Plan of Reorganization of Purdue Pharma L.P. and its Affiliated Debtors dated March 19, 2025, a copy of which is On File with the Legislative Services Division. This authorization shall include, but is not limited to, authorization to execute documents, in whatever form they may take, as are necessary to effectuate the intent of this Ordinance without further action by the City Council.

Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that counsel representing the City in the Opioid Litigation must submit a Master Ballot vote on behalf of the City to accept the Plan on or before

September 5, 2025. 1 Section 4. Effective Date.
