5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING A \$224,959.50 GRANT
6 FROM THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY,
7 FUNDED THROUGH THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT
8 PROGRAM AND APPROVED BY THE FLORIDA DIVISION
9 OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FOR THE PURCHASE AND
10 INSTALLATION OF A PERMANENT GENERATOR AT THE
11 TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT FACILITY, AS INITIATED BY
12 B.T. 20-094; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE
13 MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION
14 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON
15 BEHALF OF THE CITY, THE HAZARD MITIGATION
16 GRANT PROGRAM CONTRACT NUMBER H0429 BETWEEN
17 THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE FLORIDA
18 DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT; PROVIDING
19 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION
20 OF THE CITY'S DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS;
21 AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR CAPITAL
22 IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
23 2019-505-E TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT
24 ENTITLED "TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT FACILITY
25 GENERATOR REPLACEMENT"; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
26 DATE.

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28 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
30 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
31 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to

8 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

9 The funding above is a grant from the Federal Emergency
10 Management Agency, funded through the Hazard Mitigation
11 Grant Program and approved by the Florida Division of
12 Emergency Management, for the purchase and installation
13 of a permanent generator at the Traffic Management
14 Facility.

15 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
16 Section 1 is to provide funding for the purchase and installation
17 of a permanent generator at the Traffic Management Facility. The
18 purchase and installation of a permanent generator will reduce
19 and/or mitigate the damage that might occur as the result of severe
20 weather or other hazards.

21 **Section 3. Approval and authorization.** There is hereby
22 approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation
23 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on
24 behalf of the City, the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program Contract
25 Number H0429 between the City of Jacksonville and the Florida
26 Division of Emergency Management, a copy of which has been placed
27 **ON FILE** with the Office of Legislative Services.

28 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Public Buildings Division
29 of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the project
30 described herein.

31 **Section 5. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being

1 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City
2 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to
3 provide funding for the project entitled "Traffic Signals Generator
4 Replacement." The project is more fully described in the Project
5 Information Sheet, attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated
6 herein by this reference. The Council finds that the deferral of
7 this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP
8 review will be detrimental to the best interests of the community
9 because such deferral will result in the City's loss of needed
10 grant dollars. Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*,
11 enactment of this ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-
12 thirds of the Council members present at the meeting because of the
13 CIP amendment set forth in this section. This ordinance shall
14 constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other
15 respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program approved by
16 Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue in full force and effect.

17 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
18 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
19 without the Mayor's signature.
