Bill Summary: The bill amends Ordinance Code Chapter 381 – Solid Waste Management – to reduce the minimum required recycling percentage for construction and demolition debris recycling facilities to 51% for 2023 and years thereafter. The Solid Waste Division of the Public Works Department is designated at the City's oversight agency for this purpose.

Background Information: The Code currently requires that the holders of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate a construction and demolition debris recycling facility must recycle a minimum of 86% of the materials received at the facility in 2023 and a minimum of 87% of the materials received in 2024 and years thereafter. This bill would reduce that minimum recycling percentage to 51% for 2023 and years thereafter. The current mandatory recycling percentages were established via Ordinance 2019-111-E.
