Bill Summary: This bill provides the City's recommendations to the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization for priority projects for the TPO's 2025 List of Priority Projects.

Background Information: The North Florida Transportation Planning Organization is the independent regional transportation planning agency for Duval, Clay, Nassau and St. Johns counties, responsible for annually prioritizing projects in the region for which federal transportation funding is being sought. The City of Jacksonville makes recommendations each year by adopting a Resolution by the City Council. Projects by category: Roadway Capacity Improvements: 15 projects (3 new); Tie-in to Resurfacing Projects: 3 projects; Sun Trails Projects: 4 projects; FDOT/TAP Projects: 4 projects (2 new); Walk audits for Jacksonville Heights Elementary and Hyde Grove Elementary.
