ORDINANCE 2025-890

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER A THIRD AMENDMENT TO LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND DINSMORE CIVIC ASSOCIATION, INC. ("LICENSEE"), EXTENDING THE TERM OF THE LICENSE AGREEMENT TO APRIL 6, 2030, ONE (1) ADDITIONAL FIVE-YEAR RENEWAL OPTION, AT AN ANNUAL LICENSE FEE RATE OF \$1.00, WITH RESPECT TO THE BUILDING COMMONLY KNOWN AS THE DINSMORE HISTORICAL MUSEUM LOCATED GENERALLY AT 7330 CIVIC CLUB DRIVE, JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32219; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville ("City") and Dinsmore Civic Association, Inc. ("Licensee"), previously entered into that certain License Agreement dated April 7, 2010, as amended by that certain First Amendment to License Agreement dated September 1, 2015, and as further amended by that certain Second Amendment to License Agreement dated June 20, 2023, (collectively, the "License Agreement"), for the license of the building commonly known as the Dinsmore Historical Museum (the "Museum"), located generally at 7330 Civic Club Drive, Jacksonville, Florida 32219; and

WHEREAS, the City has worked with the Licensee with respect to the management and programing of the Museum since April 7, 2010,

pursuant to Ordinance 2010-872-E;

WHEREAS, the Licensee has worked diligently at the Museum to provide a repository for artifacts and materials from earlier, historic years in the history of the Dinsmore North Jacksonville community and the Museum features a variety of exhibits and artifacts that tell the story of the Dinsmore family and the many generations of African Americans who lived and worked on the property;

WHEREAS, the License Agreement expired on April 6, 2025 but the Licensee has continued to operate and maintain the Museum in accordance with the terms of the License Agreement;

WHEREAS, the Licensee has requested the City to enter into an Amendment Three to License Agreement in substantially the form placed On File with the Legislative Services Division (the "Amendment") which will be effective as of April 7, 2025 in order to maintain continuity and accurately reflect Licensee's continued operation of the Museum since that time, and will extend the term of the License Agreement for five (5) years with one (1) renewal option for a five (5) year term; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Approval and authorization to execute Amendment Three to License Agreement approved. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor or her designee and Corporation Secretary are authorized to enter into the Amendment. The Amendment reinstates the License Agreement and extends the term of the License Agreement with respect to the Museum to April 6, 2030, with one (1), five-year renewal option, at an annual license fee rate of \$1.00, with all other terms and conditions of the License Agreement remaining unchanged.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall have oversight of the project described herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
