Type of Action: Appropriation; authorize positions; approve and authorize the Mayor to produce documents related to the use of funds; waive provisions of Section 106.303, *Ordinance Code*

Bill Summary: This bill appropriates \$1,471,237.53, including \$504,441 in revenue collected from the Foreclosure Registry and a reallocation of previously appropriated funds in the amount of \$966,796 to fund various programs and activities authorized pursuant to Chapter 179, *Ordinance Code*, as initiated by BT 27-005. The bill authorizes positions, as initiated by RC 27-004. It also authorizes and approves the Mayor to execute and deliver any documents related to the use of authorized funds. The bill waives the provisions of Section 106.303, *Ordinance Code*, to allow modification of the appropriation of funds exhibit to facilitate compliance with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.

Background Information: The purpose of the appropriation is to provide funding for various programs and activities pursuant to Chapter 179, *Ordinance Code*. The funds collected relate to real property mortgages in default.

Policy Impact Area: Mortgage Foreclosure Registry

Fiscal Impact: The bill appropriates \$1,471,237.53, as initiated by BT 27-005.
