Type of Action: Appropriation, *Ordinance Code* waivers, agreement authorization, CIP amendment, designation of oversight agency and one cycle emergency passage

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$75,000 from the Traffic Calming – District 08 – Other Construction Costs account to the Kids Hope Alliance Fund – ESP – Out-of School-Time – Subsidies and Contributions to Private Org account. Sections 77.101 and 77.111 *Ordinance Code* are waived. The agreement between the City and Goodwill Industries of North Florida is authorized. The 2026-2030 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan is amended to reflect the funds for this project. KHA will provide oversight. One cycle emergency passage is requested so as to provide funds for the program as soon as possible.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for the Summer Youth Works Program will provide job and hands-on training opportunities to 25 young adults aged 16 to 24 years old residing within Duval County. The waivers are required to permit a direct contract with Goodwill and permit services to be provided to participants between 16 and 24 years old. The funds will be used to compensate participants with an hourly wage and for administrative support.
