WHEREAS, during his leadership tenure, Chief Powers guided the Department through critical missions, including statewide wildland firefighting deployments in 1998, Urban Search and Rescue efforts during Hurricane Katrina, and administrative leadership of JFRD's Tactical Support Facility overseeing hundreds of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Chief Powers led JFRD through the COVID-19 pandemic, supporting community testing and vaccination efforts while maintaining critical emergency response capabilities; and

WHEREAS, he has been publicly praised by community leaders and served the citizens of Jacksonville with integrity, professionalism, and compassion, Chief Powers himself has referred to his service as
