8 IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT FUND TO THE SOUTHSIDE
9 SENIOR CENTER ART IN PUBLIC PLACES PROJECT TO
10 PROVIDE FUNDING FOR INSTALLATION OF PUBLIC ART,
11 AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T. 22-033; PURPOSE OF
12 APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2022-2026 FIVE-YEAR
13 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY ORDINANCE
14 2021-505-E TO REFLECT THIS APPROPRIATION OF
15 FUNDS TO THE PROJECT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
16 DATE.
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18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
20 within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
22 listed in subsection (b):

24 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Rev B.T. 22-033, January 31, 2022 - NCSPHS"
25 and incorporated herein by this reference)

31 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$32,000

1 from the Art in Public Places Project fund to the Southside
2 Senior Center Art in Public Places project (the "Project")
3 to provide funding for installation of public art.

4 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
5 Section 1 is to appropriate funds to the Southside Senior Center Art
6 in Public Places project to pay the costs for installation of a three-
7 dimensional public art piece at this location.

8 **Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance
9 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
10 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is
11 hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the
12 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets
13 attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2,
14 Rev CIP, January 31, 2022 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this
15 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment
16 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be
17 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such
18 deferral will unnecessarily delay the opportunity to bring public art
19 to this part of the community.

20 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of
21 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
22 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP
23 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute
24 an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the
25 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E
26 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

27 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
29 without the Mayor's signature.
