LANTIE ELISABETH JORANDBY, AS A MEMBER OF THE 6 7 OPIOID AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER GRANTS 8 AS A HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL COMMITTEE, 9 REPRESENTATIVE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 84.202 (COMPOSITION; CITY COUNCIL LIAISON; TERMS; 10 11 REMOVAL), PART 2 (OPIOID AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER GRANTS COMMITTEE), CHAPTER 84 (OPIOID 12 13 SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM ENDING ON JUNE 30, 2025; 14 15 ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL BUSINESS INTEREST IN DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 50.102(B) 16 17 (RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION), CHAPTER 50 18 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS 19 AND COMMISSIONS), 20 ORDINANCE CODE; WAIVING COUNCIL RULE 4.1101 21 (APPEARANCE BEFORE COMMITTEE), COUNCIL RULES, 22 REQUIREMENT THAT THE APPOINTEE PRIOR ΤO 23 CONFIRMATION APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMITTEE ТО 24 WHICH CONSIDERATION OF THE APPOINTMENT HAS BEEN 25 REFERRED; REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY 26 PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, Ordinance 2023-350-E established the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee (the "Committee") to act as an advisory body for the City of Jacksonville and to review, evaluate and score grant applications to fund projects and programs aimed at 1 combatting the opioid crisis; and

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2 WHEREAS, Section 84.202, Ordinance Code, outlines the 3 composition of the Committee which shall consist of seven voting 4 members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed 5 by Council and three of whom shall be appointed by the Council 6 President and confirmed by Council; and

7 WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council President shall each appoint 8 one member to the Committee from each of the following categories: 9 (i) Mental Health Professional, (ii) Peer Specialist, and (iii) 10 Healthcare Professional; and

WHEREAS, the members of the Committee are chosen to provide knowledge of needed services, shall demonstrate an interest in the impact of opioid-related programs in the community, and a willingness to participate fully in the process; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Appointment. The Council hereby confirms the 16 Section 1. Mayor's appointment of Dr. Lantie Elisabeth Jorandby to the Opioid 17 and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee, as a Healthcare 18 19 Professional representative, in accordance with Section 84.202 20 (Composition; City Council Liaison; Terms; Removal), Part 2 (Opioid 21 and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee), Chapter 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), Ordinance Code, for a first full term 22 23 expiring on June 30, 2025.

24 A Non-Resident of Duval County with substantial Section 2. 25 economic business interests in Duval County. Section 50.102 (Members 26 of Boards and Commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50 27 (Organization of Boards and Commissions), Ordinance Code, requires Board and Commission members be either a Duval Country resident or 28 29 individuals with substantial economic business interests in Duval 30 County. Dr. Jorandby has substantial business interests in Duval 31 County. Since 2019, Dr. Jorandby has been serving as the Chief Medical

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Officer for Lakeview Health, a dual diagnosis treatment facility
located in Jacksonville, Florida.

3 Section 3. Waiver of Council Rule 4.1101 (Appearance Before Committee), Council Rules. Council Rule 4.1101 (Appearance Before 4 5 Committee), Council Rules, is hereby waived as to the requirement that the appointee prior to confirmation appear before the committee 6 7 to which consideration of the appointment has been referred. A waiver is required because the appointee is unable to appear before the 8 Rules Committee due to a scheduling conflict. This waiver will allow 9 the Rules Committee and Council to act upon this appointment in a 10 11 timely manner to give the Committee sufficient time to schedule 12 organizational and training meetings to prepare for the initial grant cycle and to allow the appointee to attend and participate in those 13 14 meetings as a member of the Committee.

Requesting One-cycle emergency Passage Pursuant 15 Section 4. to Council Rule 4.901 (Declaration of Emergency), Part 9 (Emergency 16 Legislation), Chapter 4 (Procedures). One-cycle emergency passage 17 of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that 18 applications for the initial Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants cycle 19 20 (Fiscal Year 2023-2024) must be submitted by no later than September 21 30, 2023. The City Council would like to seat the Committee members 22 as soon as possible to provide the members and staff time to schedule 23 their initial organizational and training meetings to prepare for the 24 grant cycle.

25 Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 27 without the Mayor's signature.
