Bill Summary: This bill reappoints Mia Jones to the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Board of Trustees, for a second four-year term to expire on June 30, 2028.

Background Information: The Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Board of Trustees is established pursuant to Article 22, *Jacksonville Charter*, as the sole entity responsible for administering the Pension Fund.

Sections 175.061 and 185.05, *Florida Statutes*, provide that two of the members of the board must be appointed by the legislative body of the municipality. Section 22.02(a), *Jacksonville Charter*, provides that the trustees appointed by the City Council be legal residents of the City of Jacksonville with at least 10 years of professional financial experience.

Ms. Jones holds a bachelor's degree in accounting and an MBA from FAMU. She is the Chief Executive Officer of AGAPE Community Health Center, Inc. Ms. Jones served on the Jacksonville City Council from 2003 to 2008, District 10, and for eight years in the Florida House of Representatives, District 14. Ms. Jones resides within the city of Jacksonville in Council District 8.
