Type of Action: Approving non-residential solid waste collection and transport franchise agreement; designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: The bill authorizes the granting of a non-residential solid waste collection and transportation franchise to Maco Partners, Inc. (d/b/a Frog Hauling and Demolition). The Solid Waste Division of the Public Works Department is designated as the oversight agency for the franchise agreement.

Background Information: The franchise authorizes the company to contract for waste collection and disposal with businesses in the City of Jacksonville (excluding the Beaches cities and Baldwin). The applicant has paid the \$1,500 application fee and franchise haulers pay a franchise fee of 17% of gross revenues to the City. The franchise is for a period of one year, renewable annually upon the payment of a renewal fee.

Policy Impact Area: Solid waste collection and disposal

Fiscal Impact: The company has paid the \$1,500 application fee and will pay a franchise fee of 17% of gross revenues.
