5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$5,000 FROM PRIVATE
6 DONATIONS TO THE JUMP START PROGRAM
7 ADMINISTERED BY NE FLORIDA SOBER LIVING
8 ALLIANCE, INC. WITHIN THE OPIOID ABUSE
9 PROGRAM TRUST FUND; APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING
10 THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION
11 SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, AN AGREEMENT
12 BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND NE
13 FLORIDA SOBER LIVING ALLIANCE, INC.; INVOKING
14 THE EXCEPTION IN SECTION 126.107(G), *ORDINANCE*
15 *CODE*, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH NE FLORIDA
16 SOBER LIVING ALLIANCE, INC. TO PROVIDE THE
17 SERVICES FOR THE JUMP START PROGRAM; PROVIDING
18 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF GRANTS AND
19 CONTRACT COMPLIANCE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
20 DATE.

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22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2020-2021 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
26 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

2 (c) **Explanation of Appropriation** - The funding above is being
3 appropriated from private donations to the Jump Start
4 Program administered by NE Florida Sober Living Alliance,
5 Inc. within the Opioid Abuse Program Trust Fund to be
6 utilized for the Jump Start program.

7 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
8 Section 1 is to provide funding for the Jump Start program, as more
9 fully described in **Exhibit 2** attached hereto. The Jump Start
10 program administered by NE Florida Sober Living Alliance, Inc.
11 will utilize this funding as a stopgap measure to provide daily
12 living assistance to individuals suffering from opioid dependence
13 or addiction with daily housing vouchers. The cost per voucher is
14 \$27 and these funds are estimated to assist 37 individuals.

15 **Section 3. Agreement approved and execution authorized.**
16 There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and
17 Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver,
18 the Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and NE
19 Florida Sober Living Alliance, Inc., in substantially the form as
20 attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**, and incorporated herein by this
21 reference (the "Agreement"). The Agreement may include such
22 additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary
23 and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be
24 acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and
25 acceptance being evidenced by execution of the Agreement by the
26 Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modification to the
27 Agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of
28 the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the
29 Agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of NE Florida
30 Sober Living Alliance, Inc., and any such modification shall be
31 technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and

1 approval by the Office of General Counsel. For the purposes of this
2 Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes
3 having no financial impact to the City and any other non-
4 substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties
5 and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the
6 Agreement.

7 **Section 4. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g),**
8 **Ordinance Code.** The City is hereby authorized to procure the use of
9 the professional services of NE Florida Sober Living Alliance,
10 Inc., to provide services for the Jump Start program. Pursuant to
11 Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations),
12 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), *Ordinance Code*, such procurement is
13 exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or
14 services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within
15 authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the
16 exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126,
17 *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

18 **Section 5. Oversight.** The Mayor is requested to appoint
19 the Office of Grants and Contract Compliance to oversee the project
20 in Section 2 above and to ensure compliance with all other
21 appropriate laws.

22 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
23 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
24 without the Mayor's signature.
