ORDINANCE CONCERNING EMERGENCY MEDICAL ΑN TRANSPORTATION SERVICES; MAKING FINDINGS; DECLARING THAT PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE THE TRANSFER OR ASSIGNMENT OF CERTIFICATE FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FROM CENTURY AMBULANCE SERVICE, INC. TO RG AMBULANCE SERVICE, INC.; AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF THE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT, OR DESIGNEE, TO TRANSFER OR ASSIGN CERTIFICATE; REQUESTING SAID EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUED OPERATION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Findings. The Council finds that:

- RG Ambulance Service, Inc. ("RG Ambulance") is a private ambulance provider currently operating in Miami-Dade and Broward Counties.
- RG Ambulance is in the process of acquiring another private ambulance service provider, Century Ambulance Service, Inc. ("Century Ambulance"), which currently provides emergency transportation services within Duval County through a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity ("COPCN) issued by the City of Jacksonville, Certificate Number 100-304-A. The anticipated closing for the transaction is scheduled for September 14, 2023.
- (c) Century Ambulance wishes to transfer Certificate Number 100-304-A to RG Ambulance as a part of the closing to allow RG

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Ambulance to provide emergency medical transportation services to the residents of Duval County.

- (d) Section 158.214, Ordinance Code, provides that no COPCN "...shall be assignable or transferable by the holder of the certificate except on approval by the [City] Council."
- (e) RG Ambulance has submitted the formal application to the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department ("JFRD") as well as the required filing fee of \$2,000.00. The application is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**. JFRD has reviewed the application and has recommended approval of the transfer of this Certificate.
- (f) Continued operation of the emergency medical transportation services is in the best interests of the residents of the City of Jacksonville.
- (g) The immediate transfer of Century Ambulance's Certificate to RG Ambulance is necessary to allow the transition of Century Ambulance emergency medical transportation services to RG Ambulance and to provide uninterrupted service to the community.
- (h) Continued operation of the emergency medical transportation services by RG Ambulance from the date of transfer of the Certificate to RG Ambulance is in the best interests of the residents of the City.
- Section 2. Transfer of Certificate. The public convenience and necessity require the transfer or assignment of Century Ambulance Certificate Number 100-304-A to RG Ambulance to operate the vehicle(s) listed in its application for emergency medical transportation services. The Director of JFRD, or his designee, is hereby authorized to transfer or assign Certificate Number 100-304-A from Century Ambulance to RG Ambulance.
- Section 3. Continued Operation. In order to effect a transition of Century Ambulance emergency medical transportation services to RG Ambulance without interruption to the community,

Century Ambulance is authorized by the Council to continue providing

the emergency medical transportation services under its previous Certificate Number 100-304-A until the transition to RG Ambulance is complete.

Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant Section 4. to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to avoid the interruption of emergency medical transportation services in Duval County. The closing date for RG Ambulance to purchase Century Ambulance Service is scheduled for September 14, 2023. To operate within Duval County, RG Ambulance must also acquire Century Ambulance's Certificate Number 100-304-A.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
