AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$2,395,000.00 FROM THE PUBLIC BUILDING ALLOCATIONS FUND, INCLUDING THE \$2,366,627.21 FROM PUBLIC BUILDINGS UTILITIES, ELECTRICITY - UTILITY BILLS ACCOUNT \$28,372.79 FROM THE PWPB BUILDING MAINTENANCE - PUBLIC BUILDINGS OTHER GOVERNMENTAL, CONTRIBUTION - LOSS DEDUCTIBLE ACCOUNT, TO PAY THE COSTS FOR ELECTRICAL REPAIRS TO THE ST. JAMES BUILDING (CITY HALL) BY MILLER COMPANY; FOR ELECTRIC PROVIDING PROJECT OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, PUBLIC BUILDINGS DIVISION; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above is an appropriation of \$2,395,000.00 from

the Public Building Allocations Fund, including \$2,366,627.21 from the Public Buildings Utilities, Electricity - Utility Bills account and \$28,372.79 from the PWPB Building Maintenance - Public Buildings - Other General Governmental, Contribution - Loss Deductible account, to procure labor and materials from Miller Electric Company for electrical repairs for the St. James Building (City Hall).

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to procure labor and materials from Miller Electric Company for repairs to City Hall electrical systems as more specifically described in the proposal attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. The work will entail a comprehensive replacement of the bus duct at City Hall and is expected to have a significant lead time due to the nature of the parts to be replaced.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Department of Public Works, Public Buildings Division, shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that it is expected to take 20 to 30 weeks to order and receive the parts necessary to make the required electrical repairs to City Hall. The City desires to initiate that purchase as soon as possible to avoid the potential for loss of power to the building.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
