Bill Summary: This resolution approves and authorizes the execution of an Economic Development Agreement between the City and Project Moana (Company) to support the expansion of the Company's existing distribution facility in Jacksonville. To that end, the bill also approves and/or authorizes: a REV grant not to exceed \$2,500,000; execution of documents by the Mayor; and technical amendments by the Executive Director of the Office of Economic Development. The bill designates the Office of Economic Development (OED) as the oversight department.

Background Information: Project Moana, a Targeted Industry Company, has committed to expanding its existing operations in the City with an anticipated capital investment of \$90,000,000 and has committed to retaining 480 existing jobs and creating 100 new jobs with an average salary, exclusive of benefits, of \$52,000 by December 31, 2029. The company has requested, and the City has agreed to provide public investment in the company's project in the form of a 5-year, 60% REV Grant in the maximum amount of \$2,500,000. The OED has reviewed the application from the company for community development and negotiated an Economic Development. This bill approves that Agreement and authorizes the Mayor and the Office of Economic Development to execute and oversee the Agreement.

Policy Impact Area: Economic development, workforce development

Fiscal Impact: This bill authorizes the Mayor to disburse annual REV Grant installments not exceeding \$2,500,000.
