5 A ORDINANCE CONFIRMING THE APPOINTMENT OF DR.  
6 LANTIE ELISABETH JORANDBY, AS A MEMBER OF THE  
7 OPIOID AND SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER GRANTS  
8 COMMITTEE, AS A HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL  
9 REPRESENTATIVE, PURSUANT TO SECTION 84.202  
10 (COMPOSITION; CITY COUNCIL LIAISON; TERMS;  
11 REMOVAL), PART 2 (OPIOID AND SUBSTANCE USE  
12 DISORDER GRANTS COMMITTEE), CHAPTER 84 (OPIOID  
13 SETTLEMENT PROCEEDS GRANTS), *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR  
14 A FIRST FULL TERM ENDING ON JUNE 30, 2025;  
15 ESTABLISHING SUBSTANTIAL BUSINESS INTEREST IN  
16 DUVAL COUNTY, PURSUANT TO SECTION 50.102(B)  
17 (RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT) (MEMBERS OF BOARDS AND  
18 COMMISSIONS), PART 1 (ORGANIZATION) CHAPTER 50  
19 (ORGANIZATION OF BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS),  
20 *ORDINANCE CODE*; WAIVING COUNCIL RULE 4.1101  
21 (APPEARANCE BEFORE COMMITTEE), COUNCIL RULES,  
22 REQUIREMENT THAT THE APPOINTEE PRIOR TO  
23 CONFIRMATION APPEAR BEFORE THE COMMITTEE TO  
24 WHICH CONSIDERATION OF THE APPOINTMENT HAS BEEN  
25 REFERRED; REQUESTING ONE-CYCLE EMERGENCY  
26 PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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28 **WHEREAS**, Ordinance 2023-350-E established the Opioid and  
29 Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee (the "Committee") to act as  
30 an advisory body for the City of Jacksonville and to review, evaluate  
31 and score grant applications to fund projects and programs aimed at

1 combatting the opioid crisis; and

2       **WHEREAS**, Section 84.202, *Ordinance Code*, outlines the  
3 composition of the Committee which shall consist of seven voting  
4 members, three of whom shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed  
5 by Council and three of whom shall be appointed by the Council  
6 President and confirmed by Council; and

7       **WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council President shall each appoint  
8 one member to the Committee from each of the following categories:  
9 (i) Mental Health Professional, (ii) Peer Specialist, and (iii)  
10 Healthcare Professional; and

11       **WHEREAS**, the members of the Committee are chosen to provide  
12 knowledge of needed services, shall demonstrate an interest in the  
13 impact of opioid-related programs in the community, and a willingness  
14 to participate fully in the process; now therefore

15       **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

16       **Section 1. Appointment.** The Council hereby confirms the  
17 Mayor's appointment of Dr. Lantie Elisabeth Jorandby, a Duval County  
18 resident, to the Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee,  
19 as a Healthcare Professional representative, in accordance with  
20 Section 84.202 (Composition; City Council Liaison; Terms; Removal),  
21 Part 2 (Opioid and Substance Use Disorder Grants Committee), Chapter  
22 84 (Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants), *Ordinance Code*, for a first  
23 full term expiring on June 30, 2025.

24       **Section 2. A Non-Resident of Duval County with substantial**  
25 **economic business interests in Duval County.** Section 50.102 (Members  
26 of Boards and Commissions), Part 1 (Organization), Chapter 50  
27 (Organization of Boards and Commissions); *Ordinance Code*, requires  
28 Board and Commission members be either a Duval Country resident or  
29 individuals with substantial economic business interests in Duval  
30 County. Dr. Jorandby has substantial business interests in Duval  
31 County. Since 2019, Dr. Jorandby has been serving as the Chief medical

1 Office for Lakeview Health, a dual diagnosis treatment facility  
2 located in Jacksonville, Florida.

3       **Section 3. Waiver of Council Rule 4.1101 (Appearance Before**  
4 **Committee), Council Rules.** Council Rule 4.1101 (Appearance Before  
5 Committee), *Council Rules*, is hereby waived as to the requirement  
6 that the appointee prior to confirmation appear before the committee  
7 to which consideration of the appointment has been referred. A waiver  
8 is required because the appointee is unable to appear before the  
9 Rules Committee due to a scheduling conflict. This waiver will allow  
10 the Rules Committee and Council to act upon this appointment in a  
11 timely manner to give the Committee sufficient time to schedule  
12 organizational and training meetings to prepare for the initial grant  
13 cycle and to allow the appointee to attend and participate in those  
14 meetings as a member of the Committee.

15       **Section 4. Requesting One-cycle emergency Passage Pursuant**  
16 **to Council Rule 4.901 (Declaration of Emergency), Part 9 (Emergency**  
17 **Legislation), Chapter 4 (Procedures).** One-cycle emergency passage  
18 of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that  
19 applications for the initial Opioid Settlement Proceeds Grants cycle  
20 (Fiscal Year 2023-2024) must be submitted by no later than September  
21 30, 2023. The City Council would like to seat the Committee members  
22 as soon as possible to provide the members and staff time to schedule  
23 their initial organizational and training meetings to prepare for the  
24 grant cycle.

25       **Section 5. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become  
26 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
27 without the Mayor's signature.
