The proposed legislation is a recommendation of the Industrial Development Revenue Bond (IRB) Review Committee, that the Mayor submit legislation to approve, for purposes of Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code, the issuance of City of Jacksonville, Florida Health Care Facilities Revenue Bonds for the Southern Baptist Hospital of Florida, Inc., d/b/a Baptist Medical Center Jacksonville and Baptist Medical Center South ("Baptist Health" Project) in one or more installments or series, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$150,000,000. The bond issuance will be for the purpose of financing, refinancing and reimbursing all or a part of the cost of said projects.

The City, as a conduit, proposes to issue its Health Care Facilities Revenue Bonds (Baptist Health), Series 2021 for the purpose of the acquisition, planning, development, construction, renovation, improvement, equipping and installation of certain facilities, and other capital improvements and upgrades, as more particularly described on Exhibit A hereto (collectively, the "Baptist Health" Project), all in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 159, Florida Statutes, as amended, and Chapter 104 of Ordinance Code of the City, and other applicable provisions of law.
