ORDINANCE 2025-716

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$390,673 FROM THE CIP DEBT SERVICE REPAYMENT - ISA-DEBT MANAGEMENT FUND - INTEREST ACCOUNT TO THE NORTH FLORIDA REGIONAL COUNCIL - SUBSIDIES AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO OTHER GOVT ACCOUNT, TO FUND THE CITY OF JACSONVILLE/DUVAL COUNTY'S ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE NORTHEAST FLORIDA REGIONAL COUNCIL FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER TO FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$390,673 from the CIP Debt Service Repayment - ISA-Debt Management Fund - Interest account to the North Florida Regional

Council - Subsidies and Contributions to Other Govt account
to pay the City of Jacksonville/Duval County's annual
contribution for participation in the Northeast Florida
Regional Council for Fiscal Year 2025-2026.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in
Section 1 is to fund the City's annual contribution for participation
in the Northeast Florida Regional Council for Fiscal Year 2025-2026.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated herein shall
not lapse but shall carryover to Fiscal Year 2025-2026.

**Section 4. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant
to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the
City Council desires to ensure the funds appropriated herein do not
lapse before the end of the fiscal year.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become
effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
without the Mayor's signature.
