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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville: Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2022-2023 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$232,000 from Gain-Loss on Sale of Real Estate within Fund 32103 -Jacksonville Recreational Environmental Land Acquisition Capital Projects Fund to the Emmett Reed Community Center - Head Start Upgrades Project per Ordinance 2019-135-E.

9 Section 2. Purpose. In May 2019, Ordinance 2019-135-E 10 authorized the real estate purchase and sale agreement between the City and Load King Manufacturing Company for property located in 11 Council District 9. The proceeds of the sale of the subject parcels 12 were placed in the Jacksonville Recreational and Environmental Land 13 Acquisition Capital Projects Fund in February 2020, specifically for 14 the purpose of maintaining or acquiring park land in Council District 15 9 (\$162,000) and relocating the Head Start program to another property 16 (\$162,000). Load King paid a purchase price of \$324,000 and provided 17 an additional \$70,000 to relocate the Head Start program to another 18 19 property for a total of \$394,000. Any excess funds remaining upon 20 completion of the Head Start relocation are to be deposited into the designated account for Council District 9 within the Jacksonville 21 22 Recreational and Environmental Land Acquisition Fund.

The funds were received in February 2020 and deposited into the Jacksonville Recreational and Environmental Land Acquisition Fund (32103), PRCS Parks and Rec Capital Projects - Parks and Recreational Activity (167101). The funds fell to fund balance within Fund 32103 and must be appropriated in order to be expended in accordance with Section 3 of Ordinance 2019-135-E.

Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance
2022-505-E, adopting the 2023-2027 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan
(the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is

hereby amended to provide funding for the Emmett Reed Community Center 1 2 - Head Start Upgrades Project ("the Project") as more fully described in the Project Information Sheet attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and 3 incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that 4 the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget 5 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the 6 7 community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion 8 of the Project.

9 Pursuant to Section 122. 605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of 10 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the 11 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP 12 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute 13 an amendment to Ordinance 2022-505-E. In all other respects, the 14 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2022-505-E 15 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

16 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 17 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 18 without the Mayor's signature.
