7 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$100,000.00 IN GRANT  
8 FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW  
9 ENFORCEMENT, THROUGH ITS FY 23-24 STATE  
10 FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR FENTANYL ERADICATION  
11 (S.A.F.E.) IN FLORIDA PROGRAM, TO THE PSBU  
12 GRANTS/FENTANYL AND OPIOID ERADICATION (FOE)  
13 PROJECT FY24 TO COMBAT ILLEGAL FENTANYL  
14 ACTIVITY, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 24-051; PROVIDING  
15 FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE SHERIFF'S  
16 OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

18 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2023-2024 fiscal year,  
20 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
21 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
22 listed in subsection (b):

29 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

30 The funding above represents an appropriation of grant  
31 funds from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement,

1 through its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for  
2 Fentanyl Eradication (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to the  
3 Jacksonville Sheriff's Office PSBU Grants/Fentanyl and  
4 Opioid Eradication (FOE) Project FY24 to combat illegal  
5 fentanyl activity. The grant period commenced on July 1,  
6 2023, and continues through June 30, 2024. No local match  
7 is required.

8 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in  
9 Section 1 is to utilize the Fentanyl and Opioid Eradication (FOE)  
10 grant funding from the Florida Department of Law Enforcement through  
11 its FY 23-24 State Financial Assistance for Fentanyl Eradication  
12 (S.A.F.E.) in Florida Program, to conduct investigations designed to  
13 combat illegal fentanyl activity and will cover expenses related to  
14 overtime for such investigations. A copy of the Grant Award outlining  
15 the terms and conditions relative to the grant and use of the grant  
16 funds is attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this  
17 reference.

18 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office  
19 shall oversee administration of the grant and project described  
20 herein.

21 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
22 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
23 without the Mayor's signature.
