6 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$255,207.00 FROM
7 SIDEWALKS/BIKELANES - COUNTYWIDE AND FROM
8 SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION - NEW TO ELLIS ROAD
9 SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENT TO COMPLETE THE
10 CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SIDEWALKS ALONG THE WEST
11 SIDE OF ELLIS ROAD FROM LENOX AVENUE TO
12 NORMANDY BOULEVARD, AS INITIATED BY REVISED
13 B.T. 19-126; AMENDING THE 2020-2024 FIVE-YEAR
14 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPROVED BY
15 ORDINANCE 2019-505-E TO REDUCE FUNDING FOR THE
16 PROJECTS ENTITLED "SIDEWALKS/BIKELANES -
17 COUNTYWIDE" AND "SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION - NEW"
18 AND TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE PROJECT
19 ENTITLED "ELLIS ROAD SIDEWALK IMPROVEMENTS";
20 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2019-2020 fiscal year,
24 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the
25 indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to
26 the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

27 (Revised B.T. 19-126, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 1**, labeled
28 as "Revised Exhibit 1, Revised B.T. 19-126, November 18, 2019 -
29 NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this reference)

4 (c) Explanation of Appropriation

5 The funding above is a transfer of funds from
6 Sidewalks/Bikelanes - Countywide and from Sidewalk
7 Construction - New to Ellis Road Sidewalk Improvement to
8 complete the construction of new sidewalks along the west
9 side of Ellis Road from Lenox Avenue to Normandy
10 Boulevard. Once the project is completed, any unspent
11 dollars shall revert to the funding source listed in
12 Revised B.T. 19-126.

13 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
14 Section 1 is to provide funding to complete the construction of new
15 sidewalks along the west side of Ellis Avenue. The work will
16 include, but is not limited to, site preparation, filling in an
17 existing drainage ditch, installation of drainage piping and
18 inlets, utility adjustments, and sidewalk construction.

19 **Section 3. CIP Amendment.** Ordinance 2019-505-E, being
20 the 2020-2024 Five-Year Capital Improvement Program for the City
21 and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to
22 reduce funding for the projects entitled "Sidewalks/Bikelanes -
23 Countywide" and "'Sidewalk Construction - New" and to provide
24 funding for the project entitled "Ellis Road Sidewalk
25 Improvements." The projects are more fully described in the
26 Project Information Sheets, attached hereto as **Revised Exhibit 2**,
27 labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP, November 18, 2019 - NCSPHS"
28 and incorporated herein by this reference. The Council finds that
29 the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual
30 budget and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of
31 the community because such deferral will result in unnecessary

1 delay in the construction of sidewalk infrastructure. Pursuant to
2 Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of this ordinance
3 requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Council members
4 present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in
5 this section. This ordinance shall constitute an amendment to
6 Ordinance 2019-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital
7 Improvement Program approved by Ordinance 2019-505-E shall continue
8 in full force and effect.

9 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
