

FINANCE AMENDMENT

The Finance Committee offers the following amendment to File 2022-509:

- (1) On **page 1, 10**, after "ADMINISTRATION;" insert "DIRECTING THE PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT COUNCIL TO REOPEN THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT APPLICATION SUBMISSIONS; WAIVING THE CONFLICTING PROVISIONS OF SECTIONS 118.803 (GRANTS ADMINISTRATOR; RESPONSIBILITIES), 118.806 (APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS), 118.807 (REVIEW, EVALUATION AND SCORING OF APPLICATIONS BY PSG COUNCIL) AND 118.808 (FUNDING ALLOCATIONS BY THE PSG COUNCIL; GRANT AWARD LIMITATIONS), PART 8 (PUBLIC SERVICE GRANTS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, DUE TO THE NEED TO REOPEN THE FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 PUBLIC SERVICE GRANT APPLICATION SUBMISSIONS;";
- (2) On **page 2, line 20½**, insert a new Section 4 and Section 5 to read as follows:

" **Section 4. Directing the Public Service Grant Council to reopen Fiscal Year 2022-2023 public service grant application submissions.** The Public Service Grant Council ("PSG Council") is directed to reopen and accept additional grant applications during a limited seven (7) day grant application period. The proposed seven (7) day grant application period would commence on October 1, 2022, and end on October 7, 2022 ("Limited Grant Application Period"). The Limited Grant Application

Period would be open to any requesting agency who did not apply initially or whose application was submitted but not accepted due to untimeliness. As a result of the Limited Grant Application Period, the Council hereby adopts the extended public service grant application deadline dates set forth on **Exhibit 3** attached hereto. Additionally, the PSG Council is directed to reassess and/or rescore any Fiscal Year 2022-2023 grant applications scored by the PSG Council prior to the adoption of this ordinance, as applicable.

Section 5. Waiving conflicting provisions of Sections 118.803 (Grants Administrator; Responsibilities), 118.806 (Application Requirements), 118.807 (Review, evaluation and scoring of applications by PSG Council), 118.808 (Funding Allocations by the PSG Council; Grant Award Limitations), Part 8 (Public Service Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code. The conflicting provisions of Sections 118.803 (Grants Administrator; Responsibilities), 118.806 (Application Requirements), 118.807 (Review, evaluation and scoring of applications by PSG Council), 118.808 (Funding Allocations by the PSG Council; Grant Award Limitations), Part 8 (Public Service Grants), Chapter 118 (City Grants), *Ordinance Code*, are hereby waived to accommodate the extended public service grant application deadline dates set forth on **Exhibit 3** attached hereto and to waive the Mandatory Application Workshop requirement and courtesy application reviews.

This waiver shall not prohibit PSG Council staff from providing application workshop materials to potential grant applicants or performing courtesy reviews of PSG grant applications.”;

- (3) Renumber remaining Sections accordingly;
- (4) Attach **Exhibit 3**, attached hereto, which attaches the Limited Grant Application Period for the Public Service Grant Council;
- (5) On **page 1, line 1**, amend the introductory sentence to add that the bill was amended as reflected herein.
