7 AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING SURPLUS PERSONAL
8 PROPERTY OF THE CITY; DECLARING THAT CERTAIN
9 2015 CHEVROLET 3500HD 6.0L V8 HORTON RESCUE UNIT
10 (VIN 1GB3CZCG1FF180231, VEHICLE NUMBER 3526-30)
11 VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$7,000 AND THAT CERTAIN
12 2004 PIERCE DASH PUMPER CAT C-12 IN6 FIRE TRUCK
13 (VIN 4P1CD01W54A004380 15833, VEHICLE NUMBER
14 3355-20) VALUED AT APPROXIMATELY \$4,000 TO BE
15 SURPLUS TO THE NEEDS OF THE CITY AND AUTHORIZING
16 THE APPROPRIATE OFFICIALS OF THE CITY TO
17 TRANSFER TITLE OF SAID PROPERTY TO THE FORT
18 MYERS BEACH FIRE CONTROL DISTRICT, LOCATED AT
19 100 VOORHIS STREET, FORT MYERS BEACH, FLORIDA
20 33931, FOR USE IN THE PROVISION OF EMERGENCY
21 SERVICES IN THE FORT MYERS BEACH FIRE CONTROL
22 DISTRICT, AT NO COST, IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION
23 122.812(C), *ORDINANCE CODE*; DESIGNATING THE
24 JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE DEPARTMENT TO
25 MONITOR ACTUAL USE OF SAID PROPERTY; PROVIDING
26 FOR A REVERTER; REQUESTING EMERGENCY PASSAGE
27 UPON INTRODUCTION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

29 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 **Section 1. Declaration of Surplus.** The City hereby
31 declares that certain 2015 Chevrolet 3500HAD 6.0L V8 Horton Rescue

1 Unit (VIN 1GB3CZCG1FF180231, vehicle number 3526-30) valued at
2 approximately \$7,000 and that certain 2004 Pierce Dash Pumper CAT C-
3 12 IN6 Fire Truck (VIN 4P1CD01W54A004380 15833, vehicle number 3355-
4 20) valued at approximately \$4,000 (collectively, the "Subject
5 Property"), to be surplus to the needs of the City of Jacksonville
6 and authorizes the appropriate City officials to transfer title of
7 the Subject Property to the Fort Myers Beach Fire Control District,
8 located at 100 Voorhis Street, Fort Myers Beach, Florida 33931, at
9 no cost, pursuant to Section 122.812(c), *Ordinance Code*. A copy of
10 the certificate from the Chief of Procurement certifying compliance
11 with provisions of Chapter 122, *Ordinance Code*, is attached hereto
12 as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference. Copies of
13 the property transfer forms are attached hereto as **Exhibit 2**.

14 **Section 2. Public Purpose.** The surplus vehicles are needed
15 by the Fort Myers Beach Fire Control District to rebuild their
16 emergency services fleet after loss of their fire and rescue vehicles
17 during Hurricane Ian. The City of Jacksonville finds that providing
18 these surplussed vehicles to the Fort Myers Beach Fire Control
19 District to be used for the provision of critical emergency services
20 for the Fort Myers Beach community is a valid public purpose.

21 **Section 3. Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department to**
22 **Monitor Actual Use of Subject Property.** The Jacksonville Fire and
23 Rescue Department will be the designated agency to monitor the Fort
24 Myers Beach Fire Control District's use of the Subject Property in
25 accordance with the purposes set forth herein.

26 **Section 4. Reverter.** The disposition authorized herein is
27 conditioned upon the Fort Myers Beach Fire Control District using the
28 said vehicles for the purposes set forth herein and is conditioned
29 upon the Fort Myers Beach Fire Control District's agreeing to convey
30 and physically return the vehicles back to the City of Jacksonville,
31 at no cost to the City of Jacksonville, in the event that the vehicles

1 are not used for those purposes.

2 **Section 5. Requesting Emergency Passage Upon Introduction**
3 **Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** Emergency passage upon
4 introduction of this legislation is requested. The nature of the
5 emergency is that the Fort Myers Beach Fire Control District has an
6 immediate need to restore critical emergency services in Fort Myers
7 Beach community. The Fort Myers Beach Fire Control District has
8 requested donation of fire and rescue vehicles to help rebuild their
9 emergency services fleet after experiencing the devastating loss of
10 much of their own fleet during Hurricane Ian.

11 **Section 6. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
12 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
13 without the Mayor's signature.
