Type of Action: Appropriation and budget amendment

Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$15,790 from the Community Services Grants – Volunteer Expenses account to purchase food and beverage for various special events and activities for training and volunteer recognition. Ordinance 2024-504E, adopting the 2024-2025 fiscal year budget, is amended to replace the Revised Attachment A, entitled “Food and Beverage Expenditures”, to authorize expenditure of these funds.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for food and beverages for certain special events and activities hosted by the Parks, Recreation, and Community Services Department. The funds will be allocated to: the Respite for Elders in Everyday Families (RELIEF) Program (\$6,590.00), the Foster Grandparents Program (\$2,000.00), and the Senior Companion Program (\$7,200.00).
