JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC.; WAIVING 18 SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING 19 20 THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY 21 22 GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT 23 CONTRACT WITH ST. JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC.; 24 INVOKING THE EXEMPTION IN SECTION 126.108(G) 25 (EXEMPTIONS FROM COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION), 26 SUBPART A (GENERAL REGULATIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL 27 REGULATIONS; ETHICS AND TRANSPARENCY IN PUBLIC CONTRACTING), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), 28 29 ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR A DIRECT CONTRACT 30 WITH ST. JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC.; APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HER DESIGNEE, AND THE 31

CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THAT CERTAIN FUNDING AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND ST. JOHNS RIVERKEEPER, INC.; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS INTO FISCAL YEAR 2027-2028; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATRIVE SERVICES; REQUIRING A REPORT TO THE JACKSONVILLE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION BOARD; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2024-2025 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of appropriation

The funding above is appropriating fund balance from the Environmental Protection Fund to fund an environmental quality assessment of the Ribault River and Moncrief Creek watersheds (the "Project").

28 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 29 Section 1 is to provide funding to St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. for 30 the Project, which shall be completed pursuant to the terms, 31 conditions and scope of work more particularly described in that

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certain Funding Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and St.
 Johns Riverkeeper, Inc., as approved and authorized in Section 6
 below.

During its meeting on March 17, 2025, the Jacksonville Environmental Protection Board approved this expenditure, as reflected in the Monthly Meeting Summary attached hereto as **Exhibit** and incorporated herein by this reference. The Project will include an environmental quality assessment of the Ribault River and Moncrief Creek watersheds.

10 Section 3. Waiving Section 110.112, Ordinance Code. Section 11 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The 12 City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), Ordinance Code, is hereby 13 waived to allow for a partial advance payment to St. Johns 14 Riverkeeper, Inc. as provided in the Agreement.

15 Waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code. Section 4. The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through 16 17 a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), 18 Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. 19 The City finds that this waiver is justified because St. Johns Riverkeeper, 20 21 Inc. has assembled the team to perform the Project and is uniquely 22 positioned to perform the Project in a timely manner.

23 Section 5. Invoking the exemption pursuant to Section 24 126.108(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure 25 the use of the services of St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. to provide an environmental quality assessment of the Ribault River and Moncrief 26 27 Creek watersheds. Pursuant to Section 126.108(g) (Exemptions from competitive solicitation), Subpart A (General Regulations), Part 1 28 (General Regulations; Ethics and Transparency in Public Contracting), 29 30 Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is 31 exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or

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services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, *Ordinance Code*, shall remain in full force and effect.

5 Section 6. Approval and Authorization to Execute. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or her designee, and the Corporation 6 7 Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver on behalf of the City an agreement with St. Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. in an amount 8 not-to-exceed \$106,000, subject to the Scope of Services and Budget 9 more particularly described in **Revised Exhibit 3**, labeled as "Revised 10 Exhibit 3, Rev MOU, June 16, 2025 - NCSPHS" and all other contracts 11 12 and documents, including extensions, renewals and amendments to the agreement, and to otherwise take all action necessary to effectuate 13 14 the intent of this Ordinance, subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the General Counsel, or his or her designee, and the 15 City's Risk Management Division for appropriate insurance and 16 indemnification requirements in accordance with Section 128.601, 17 Ordinance Code. 18

19 Section 7. Carryover. The funds appropriated by this 20 Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2027-21 2028.

22 Section 8. Oversight Department. The Office of
23 Administrative Services shall oversee the Project.

Section 9. Reports. A report shall be submitted by St.
Johns Riverkeeper, Inc. to the Jacksonville Environmental Protection
Board at the conclusion of the Project.

27 Section 10. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall
28 become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming
29 effective without the Mayor's signature.
