Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$200,000 from the Special Council Operating Contingency established by Ordinance 2022-317-E to fund the PSG Micro-Grant Pilot Program that was included as one of the priority populations approved by Ordinance 2022-214-E. The funds will not lapse but shall carryover to FY 22-23. The Office of Grants and Contract Compliance of the Finance and Administration Department will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds to the Public Service Grant Council to fund the Micro-Grant Pilot Program established in the 2022-2023 Most Vulnerable Persons and Needs category through Ordinance 2022-214-E. Ordinance 2022-214-E specified that funding for the Micro-Grant Pilot Program would be in separate legislation. Ordinance 2022-317-E appropriated \$330,419 (the remainder of an appropriation of debt service savings from the refinancing of bonds used for various projects) to the Special Council Reserve Contingency Fund for future appropriation by council.
