Appropriation. For the 2023-2024 fiscal year, within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated 18 19 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b): 20 21 (The account information is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and 22 incorporated herein by this reference) 23 (a) Appropriated from: \$25,000 24 See Exhibit 1 25 Appropriated to: (b) \$25,000 26 See Exhibit 1 Explanation of Appropriation: 27 The funding above is an appropriation of \$25,000 from the 2.8 29 Council President's Designated Contingency Jacksonville Sheriff's Office ("JSO") for the provision of 30 traffic control services at the intersection of Wells Creek

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Parkway and Philips Highway.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding for JSO officers to conduct traffic control at the intersection of Wells Creek Parkway and Philips Highway. The funds will pay the costs for up to two (2) police officers to provide these services on Mondays through Fridays, from 6:00 a.m. until 9:00 a.m., only on days when Duval County public schools are in session. Traffic control services will only be provided when JSO officers are available and will continue until the City funds are exhausted or upon completion of the traffic signal improvements at the subject intersection, whichever occurs first.

Section 3. Reverter. Any funds remaining after completion of the project described herein shall be returned to the account of origin.

Section 4. Oversight Department. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office shall oversee the project described herein.

Section 5. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the City would like to provide traffic control at the intersection of Wells Creek Parkway and Philips Highway during the school year until traffic signal improvements are completed to address safety concerns. Traffic is at its heaviest in this area when school is in session, which is also when traffic accidents are most likely to occur.

Section 6. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
