BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Confirmation. The Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of Daniel Blanchard, a Duval County resident, to the Jacksonville Housing Authority, replacing Lisa Strange Weatherby, pursuant to Section 51A.103 (Appointment, qualifications, and tenure of commissioners; hiring of employees), Chapter 51A (Jacksonville Housing Authority), Ordinance Code, for a partial term to expire on September 16, 2026, followed by a first full term to expire on September 16,2030.

Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 (Requesting Emergency Passage). One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the Jacksonville Housing Authority requires additional board members to fill vacant seats as soon as possible to
