14 TERM TO EXPIRE ON SEPTEMBER 16, 2030; REQUESTING
15 ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN
16 EFFECTIVE DATE.
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18 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

19 **Section 1. Confirmation.** The Council hereby confirms the
20 Mayor's appointment of Daniel Blanchard, a Duval County resident, to
21 the Jacksonville Housing Authority, replacing Lisa Strange Weatherby,
22 pursuant to Section 51A.103 (Appointment, qualifications, and tenure
23 of commissioners; hiring of employees), Chapter 51A (Jacksonville
24 Housing Authority), *Ordinance Code*, for a partial term to expire on
25 September 16, 2026, followed by a first full term to expire on
26 September 16, 2030.

27 **Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
28 **to Council Rule 4.901 (Requesting Emergency Passage).** One cycle
29 emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the
30 emergency is that the Jacksonville Housing Authority requires
31 additional board members to fill vacant seats as soon as possible to

1 facilitate its ability to conduct board business.

2 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
3 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
4 without the Mayor's signature.
