Type of Action: Appointment confirmation; Ordinance Code waiver

Bill Summary: This bill confirms the appointment of James Carroll as the Chief of the Right of Way & Stormwater Maintenance Division of the Department of Public Works and waives the requirements that the Division Chief have a 4 year degree from an accredited college or university in engineering, construction or construction management & be registered by the State of Florida as a professional engineer.

Background Information: Ordinance Code Section 32.302, provides that there shall be a Division Chief of Right-of-Way and Stormwater Maintenance who shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council. The Division Chief shall have a four-year degree from an accredited college or university, in engineering, construction, or construction management, must be a registered professional engineer with a license in the State of Florida, and a have minimum of five years of experience in managing buildings or working in the fields of building management, traffic engineering, or roadway and drainage design and maintenance.

Mr. Carroll has been the Right of Way Grounds Maintenance Manager from August 2004 to present day and he has worked in the Public Works Department since 1981.
