7 A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMEMORATING THE LIFE
8 AND SERVICE OF JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE
9 DEPARTMENT ENGINEER MIKE FREELAND; PROVIDING AN
10 EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 **WHEREAS**, Mike Freeland, a Jacksonville native and graduate of
13 Paxon Middle School and Ed White High School, was hired by the
14 Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department as a firefighter in April of
15 2014; and

16 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Freeland was originally assigned to Engine 50, then
17 assigned to Rescue 16 upon his promotion to the rank of Engineer in
18 April 2019, and was transferred to Engine 73 at Cecil Commerce Center
19 as a Combat Engineer in August 2021; and

20 **WHEREAS**, in the early morning hours of November 11th, a U-Haul
21 truck crashed into a power pole near Cecil Airport, trapping the
22 driver in the crushed cab of the vehicle. During the course of an
23 extended extraction operation, while working in the cargo box of the
24 truck to attempt a rescue through the back of the cab, Engineer
25 Freeland collapsed and was immediately the subject of resuscitation
26 efforts by his fellow firefighters, and then was transported to the
27 hospital where life-saving efforts were ultimately unsuccessful; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the tragic death of Mike Freeland was the third death
29 of an active-duty firefighter experienced by the Fire and Rescue
30 Department during 2021, demonstrating the inherent dangers of the job
31 these brave men and women perform every day and their dedication to

1 the public's safety and welfare; now therefore

2 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

3 **Section 1.** The City of Jacksonville hereby honors and
4 commemorates the life and public service of Fire and Rescue Department
5 Engineer Mike Freeland and extends to his family, co-workers and
6 friends its most sincere condolences on his passing. Engineer Freeland
7 was an enthusiastic and dedicated public servant and his loss will
8 be deeply felt by all who had the good fortune to know him. His
9 service to the City will be long and gratefully remembered.

10 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
11 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
12 without the Mayor's signature.
