9 SEAT FORMERLY HELD BY JACK MEEKS, PURSUANT TO
10 SECTION 30.201 (ESTABLISHMENT; MEMBERSHIP),
11 PART 2 (PLANNING COMMISSION), CHAPTER 30
12 (PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT),
13 *ORDINANCE CODE*, FOR A FIRST FULL TERM TO EXPIRE
14 SEPTEMBER 30, 2026; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

16 **WHEREAS**, Charles Garrison was appointed to the Planning
17 Commission representing Duval County at-large pursuant to Resolution
18 2023-530-A; and

19 **WHEREAS**, given the recent resignation of Jack Meeks from the
20 Planning Commission as the Planning District 1 Representative, the
21 Mayor desires that Mr. Garrison fill the open seat for Planning
22 District 1 Representative, thereby vacating his at-large seat on the
23 Planning Commission; now therefore

24 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Reappointment.** The Council hereby confirms the
26 Mayor's reappointment of Charles Garrison, a Duval County resident,
27 to the Planning Commission as a Planning District 1 representative,
28 filling a seat formerly held by Jack Meeks, pursuant to Section 30.201
29 (Establishment; membership), Part 2 (Planning Commission), Chapter
30 30 (Planning and Development Department), *Ordinance Code*, for a first
31 full term to expire on September 30, 2026.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
