6 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING DENISE DEISLER FOR HER
7 EXEMPLARY SERVICE AS CEO OF THE JACKSONVILLE
8 HUMANE SOCIETY, RECOGNIZING HER LEADERSHIP IN
9 ANIMAL WELFARE, AND HONORING HER UPON HER
10 RETIREMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 **WHEREAS,** Denise Deisler has served as the Chief Executive
13 Officer of the Jacksonville Humane Society (JHS) since September
14 2011, bringing extensive experience in animal welfare and a passion
15 for rescue initiatives; and

16 **WHEREAS,** prior to her tenure at JHS, Denise Deisler served as
17 Chief Operating Officer of Richmond SPCA in Virginia from 1998 to
18 2007 and as the Executive Director of the Humane Society of Manatee
19 County in Florida from 2008 to 2011, each role contributing to her
20 extensive impact on animal welfare; and

21 **WHEREAS,** under her leadership, JHS implemented transformative
22 programs such as a kitten nursery and a community resource center,
23 which have significantly contributed to Jacksonville achieving and
24 maintaining a city-wide live release rate of over 90%; and

25 **WHEREAS,** Denise Deisler spearheaded a \$15 million campaign to
26 rebuild the JHS shelter following a devastating fire in 2007, leading
27 to the successful design and construction of a new state-of-the-art
28 44,000 square-foot facility that opened in November 2017; and

29 **WHEREAS,** Denise Deisler launched the Lifesaving University at
30 JHS, a pioneering program that offers training to shelter staff across
31 the country on best practices in animal welfare, significantly

1 advancing lifesaving initiatives towards a no-kill goal; and

2 **WHEREAS,** Denise Deisler has been nationally recognized for her
3 contributions to animal welfare, including being named a Maddie's
4 Fund Hero in 2018 and receiving the Best Friends Animal Society
5 National Advancement Award in 2019; and

6 **WHEREAS,** Denise Deisler's leadership and vision have left a
7 lasting impact on the Jacksonville community improving the lives of
8 countless animals and enhancing community partnerships; and

9 **WHEREAS,** Denise Deisler has announced her retirement as CEO of
10 the Jacksonville Humane Society, marking the conclusion of a
11 remarkable tenure defined by dedication, compassion and
12 transformative leadership; now therefore

13 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

14 **Section 1.** The City Council hereby honors Denise Deisler
15 for her outstanding service as CEO of the Jacksonville Humane Society,
16 her instrumental role in advancing animal welfare, and her unwavering
17 dedication to improve the lives of animals and further community
18 engagement. The Council also extends its heartfelt congratulations
19 on her retirement and wishes her the best in all future endeavors.

20 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become
21 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
22 without the Mayor's signature.
